By taking the bread and the wine, you are acknowledging that you are a sinner, without hope except in God's sovereign mercy and that you are trusting in Christ alone for your salvation. We will say, " <i>The body of Christ, broken for you</i> " as you receive the bread. As you receive the wine, we will say, " <i>The blood of Christ, poured out for you</i> ."
